There are five Trustees, Sue Osman, Robert Ascott, Patricia Mitchel, Prudence Raper, Michael Goldthorpe and a Special Adviser, Wendy Pratley. The group consists of around thirty singers, instrumentalists and actors but performances require only three or four artists at any given time. Founded in 1995 The Bold Balladiers became a registered charity in March 1996.

Their charitable aim is *The advancement* of public education in the arts of music and drama by the provision of concerts and educational workshops particularly but not exclusively in Victorian and Edwardian popular repertoire. They perform in hospitals, hospices, care homes, schools and for the general public. For the latter they have appeared in theatres, halls, churches, in marquees and the open air throughout the British Isles from Penzance to Shetland.

The new season got off to a good start with ten venues in the summer tour starting from London and ending in Coventry. These concentrated tour venues were in the West Midlands, City of York, North Yorkshire, Tyne and Wear, Co.

Durham and West Yorkshire starting on Tuesday the 30th of May and ending on Saturday 3rd June. Regrettably on the last day there was a National rail strike making the artists' homeward journey more difficult than planned.



The artists were Hollie Anne Clark, soprano, Armen Boldy, tenor and Justin Bissell, piano. The programme was entitled *Summer Melodies* and included popular ballads, operatic arias and choruses for the audience to join in. Judging by reports from the artists all the venues gave The Bold Balladiers a warm welcome. In addition to venues visited many times in the past there were three new ones including a luxury home in Leeds.

Three Hampshire dates ended the first half of the season in June and July. They were in Andover, Southampton, and Sway, near Lymington. Then September 2023 saw the Balladiers back in Surrey.

The December Christmas tours comprised ten venues. Two venues, one in Kingston-upon-Thames and the other in Sutton have proved to be most loyal and have always provided large and enthusiastic audiences. The others were in Derbyshire, North and West Yorkshire, Birmingham and the West Midlands. One home, Ebor Court in York, hosted two representatives from The Bold Balladiers' funders, *York Common Good Trust*. Most of the venues were return visits but there was a new venue in North Yorkshire at Leeming Bar Grange.

The artists were Silva McQueen, soprano, Buffy Rowe, violin and Justin Bissell, piano, all long-term members of the group.

There was then a lull until March 2024 with venues in Winchester, Southampton, and Surrey.

The Bold Balladiers had visited twentyseven venues over the year, benefitting more than five hundred elderly and infirm people.

Forward bookings included a spring programme in London and a summer tour to the north in June.
